1. Lincoln Public Schools is hosting a district wide open house this weekend featuring schools that have been recently renovated as a result of the bond election. Since Hill School is currently under construction our school will not be participating in the city-wide open house. Consider visiting other schools between 2:00-4:00 on Sunday, April 18<sup>th</sup> to see the impressive improvements made to so many of our schools. Along with Hill School, schools that are off-site will not be involved in this year's event.
2. Students in grades 3,4,5 are participating in multiple assessments this month and during the upcoming month. Testing calendars have been sent home communicating when these important assessments are administered.
3. Report cards will be sent home with students on Thursday, April 15<sup>th</sup>. Please contact your child's teacher if you have questions, concerns, or comments about your child's report card.
4. Summer school programs are available for students receiving special education services and second and third grade students that need additional support in reading and math. Please contact your child's teacher for more information. Registration forms are available in the main office.
5. May Day parties will ideally be scheduled after April 29<sup>th</sup>. This way our students focus can remain on assessment through the month of April. By moving the party back to the next week it would help a great deal!
6. Our staff will be putting efforts into planning and preparing for the end of the school year and the upcoming school year. Staff participates in the compilation of class lists and final class assignments are decided by the principal. Final class assignments are mailed home in the summer.

8. Code Red drills and Tornado drills are conducted annually along with fire drills. A tornado drill and code red drill are planned within the next two weeks.
